The new YMCA Camp Carson Junior Board has been busy over the last few months, and is launching a Junior Board Camper Closet Campaign for Camp! This volunteer group of 20 campers is collecting items and raising funds to build and fully stock a Camper Closet at YMCA Camp Carson. We have also secured a small grant to assist in the construction of this space.

We know how important it is for a camper to feel at home and comfortable at Camp Carson, and part of that is having the right supplies. This project is intended to provide supplies to scholarship campers who may not have all items for Camp – or for campers who simply forget to bring something. Campers will keep all of these items when they leave Camp.

The Camper Closet will include everything from bedding and pillows to socks and toothbrushes, so Camp staff can get anything a camper might need. We will also pre-pack some bags for scholarship campers who have let us know they are lacking some items.

### **NEW Creative Arts Space!**


