GENE MILLER

Gene Miller is a Camp Carson Hall of Fame member. He was one of our first campers, attending Camp Carson in 1940, and later joined the Camp Carson staff.

Gene was an Evansville native and Indiana University graduate, also receiving an honorary LL.D. from Indiana University in 1976. He became a reporter for Ft. Wayne Journal-Gazette, Wall Street Journal, Richmond (Va.) News Leader, and Miami Herald.

As an investigative reporter in Miami, he won two Pulitzer Prizes for reporting that saved four innocent people wrongly convicted in Florida for murder. His 1975 book "An Invitation to a Lynching" was the result of eight years of active research, writing, and activism in support of two innocent men. Gene sent galley copies of the book to the Florida Attorney General and Florida Governor, prompting the Governor to grant the men clemency.



Editor's note: in my search for a copy of "An Invitation to a Lynching", I ordered from a used bookstore, and received a copy that was signed by the author.
